Eurotorg LLC Sponsorship Policy



General Provisions and Scope of Application

The Sponsorship Policy of Eurotorg LLC has been developed taking into account the provisions of the Code of Business Ethics of Eurotorg LLC and establishes the goals, main directions, and forms of sponsorship activities of Eurotorg LLC (hereinafter referred to as "Eurotorg" or the "Company"), as well as the roles and responsibilities of employees involved in the internal procedures for providing gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance.

All local regulations, internal procedures, and management decisions must comply with this Policy.

Providing gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance is the right of the Company. Demands for providing gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance are not permitted.

Gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance may be received and used by citizens of the Republic of Belarus, foreign citizens, stateless persons, as well as individual entrepreneurs and legal entities of the Republic of Belarus.

Gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance may be provided in the form of monetary funds, other property, including property rights (including exclusive rights to intellectual property objects), electronic money, digital signs (tokens), as well as in the form of works and services.

Principles of Providing Gratuitous (Sponsorship) Assistance

Legality.

Gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance is provided by the Company in strict accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Belarus and does not violate the rights and legitimate interests of third parties.

Purposefulness and targeting.

The Company strives to provide gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance in accordance with the main goals defined by this Policy, aiming to effectively address social and environmental issues or provide support to those in need.

Scale.

The Company provides gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance in all locations of its presence, purposefully contributing to the resolution of social and environmental problems and positively impacting the quality of life of the population.

Focused charity.

The Company purposefully and systematically supports specific areas / organizations / projects through long-term cooperation with specific charitable organizations, emphasizing the effectiveness of the assistance provided.

Openness.

The Company supports transparency in sponsorship activities, demonstrates its responsibility, and contributes to building trust from society and regulatory authorities.

Employee involvement.

Openness in charity matters motivates employees to participate, enhances corporate spirit, and promotes the formation of social responsibility within the team. The Company strives to develop this activity by involving its employees in sponsorship efforts.

Development of sustainable partnerships.

Publicity in providing gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance helps attract partners who share the same values as Eurotorg and are ready to support its initiatives. Active sponsorship activities of the Company contribute to creating and maintaining long-term ties with stakeholders for jointly solving society's social problems and implementing large-scale projects.

Enhancing reputation and trust.

Sponsorship activities contribute to forming a positive image of the Company in the eyes of customers, partners, and society as a whole.

Efficiency.

Gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance is carried out considering the rational and transparent spending of financial resources to ensure maximum effect and achieve the set goals.

Main Goals of Providing Gratuitous (Sponsorship) Assistance

The Company provides gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance for the following purposes:

- support for sports and healthy lifestyle, physical culture and sports organizations;
- assistance in material and technical support for medical institutions and educational institutions;
- support for organizations engaged in social protection and providing assistance to low-income citizens, as well as persons who, due to their physical characteristics, psychophysical development features, and other circumstances, cannot independently exercise their rights and legitimate interests;
- assistance to individuals in difficult life situations;
- support for the activities of charitable organizations;
- environmental protection;
- support for religious organizations registered in the Republic of Belarus;
- and other purposes provided for by the legislation of the Republic of Belarus.

Stages of Providing Gratuitous (Sponsorship) Assistance

There are the following stages of providing gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance:

- planning the Company's budget;
- reviewing requests for assistance for compliance with the main goals of the Company defined by this Policy;
- approval and conclusion of an agreement on the provision of assistance;
- provision of assistance and control over the targeted use of funds / services.

Conclusion

Providing gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance is carried out in strict accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Belarus and the Company's local regulations.

Gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance is not provided for purposes prohibited by the legislation of the Republic of Belarus.

The Company systematically reviews the principles and goals of providing gratuitous (sponsorship) assistance and promptly responds to incoming requests for assistance.

The Company ensures internal monitoring of the implementation of this Policy, strictly adhering to the legislation of the Republic of Belarus.
